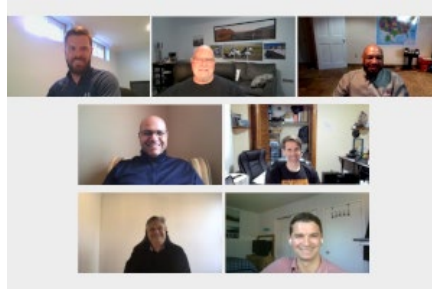

### Small-Group Bible Study Overview

BBT is for people seeking personal growth in a group setting to bridge the gap of a “spiritual life” and “life at work.”

Small groups consist of Group Leaders focusing not only on increasing personal spiritual growth but encouraging and developing Participants other spiritual leaders. A BBT Coach is available to answer any questions Group Leaders have about starting a group, choosing curriculum, or managing group dynamics.

Groups meet at work, near work (e.g., restaurants, coffee shops, etc.), or at local churches on a weekly, or biweekly, basis. Group Leaders and Participants use a BBT online/mobile technology platform to distribute the Bible study curriculum, manage meeting details and group communication, meet via private video conferencing, share prayer requests, and hold each other accountable between meetings.
